- ❖ What type of wedding do you want to have? Vibe? Feel?
- Indoor or outdoor?
- Church ceremony or justice of the peace?
- How many people are you looking to have approximately?
- What do you want to spend? Weddings are expensive and it is important to set a budget from the get go and try to adhere to it as much as possible.
- When would you like to get married? Spring? Summer? Fall? Winter?
- Open bar? Cash bar?
- Children or no children?
- Are a lot of your guests going to be traveling to your wedding?
- Do you want to have the wedding somewhere that means something to the two of you?
- Is this an evening ceremony with cocktail hour and reception or full day event?

Determine what is most important to you; it is not the same for everyone. For some people it may be having everyone they love there, for some it will be the food, others THE dress. Once you determine some of these unanswered questions you will be able to come up with a list of venues that will suit you and your significant others' needs.
